SNAP Play Scheme 2017

The Play Scheme is for all children with Additional Support Needs. The child may have a variety of additional needs, for example: physical disability, learning difficulties, a sensory impairment, or a communication disorder.

Children who live in South Lanarkshire and are aged between 5 and 16 may apply for a place at the play scheme.

There are places each day for 30 children. Due to a large demand for places at the play scheme your child may be offered a full or part time place.

This year we are running from Monday 3rd July until Friday 28th July. The play scheme runs each day Monday to Friday except for the Fair Monday. The day is from 10.00am until 3.00pm.

This year we hope to use Blacklaw Primary School as premises.

There may be limited transport provision for children living within the East Kilbride and Rutherglen areas. This will depend on South Lanarkshire Council Transport Department.

We do use public transport using Freedom Passes.

Each child must pay £10 per day. This money is used for the provision of trips and other experiences, therefore it is preferred that this is paid at the beginning of each week, where possible.

There are outings every day either in small groups, or where appropriate, the whole group goes out together.

We also run a variety of indoor activities such as drumming, sensory activities, art and drama workshops and entertainment professionals.

Each child must bring a packed lunch in an insulated container and plenty to drink.

Snacks are provided in the morning and the afternoon.

If your child requires any medication, please make sure you hand this to the bus escort in a clearly labeled container with appropriate dosage instructions.

We have trained staff at the play scheme, all of whom have a current PVG/ Disclosure Scotland Certificate. In addition, we are inspected by the regulatory body, The Care Inspectorate.

SNAP has a Child Protection policy and other relevant policies which are available to view on request.

SNAP is run by a Committee of Management who meet monthly throughout the year to raise funds for running the Play Scheme. It currently costs around £45,000 to run the play scheme for 4 weeks.
